- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: The bill legalizes the conduct of games of chance through electronic video gaming devices. The bill sets a limit on site rental; allows gaming organizations to operate up to seven video gaming devices at licensed alcoholic beverage establishments and gaming sites where bingo is the primary game of chance; requires manufacturing standards and testing and approval of video gaming devices; and requires a computer telecommunications and management information system. Except at a site where bingo is the primary game of chance conducted, if a gaming organization operates video gaming devices at a site, the organization is prohibited from conducting other games of chance at that site. The bill allocates adjusted gross proceeds (gross proceeds less prizes) between gaming tax, expenses and charitable uses; requires licensing of manufacturers, distributors, and video gaming devices; and requires background investigations of applicants. The bill provides an appropriation of \$2,000,000 and 5 full-time equivalent positions to the attorney general's office.
