Narrative:

This bill provides for the transfer of the regulation of charitable solicitations and the duties of the state athletic commissioner to the Office of the Attorney General. The bill also provides an appropriation of \$71,907 with legislative intent that 1 FTE be transferred from the Secretary of State's office to the Office of the Attorney General to serve as the Executive Director of the State Athletic Commission. The revenue from a fee based on up to 1% of gross boxing revenues is estimated to collect less than \$5,000.00
