1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

This bill has no impact on the foundation aid line item, since all schools offer the minimum number of courses. The impact on state vocational dollars is minimal, since nearly 90% of all schools currently offer 2 units of vocational coursework. Any additional courses offered would be reimbursed through existing state vocational dollars, or through federal Carl Perkins dollars. The bill will have a fiscal impact on school districts, and may require capital outlay for remodeling to include vocational classrooms and workspaces, or adding telecommunications classrooms and equipment to receive vocational or language courses via interactive sources.


