Most school districts have written agreements in place which allow for the transportation of students who are being educated under tuition agreements or the provisions of open enrollment. The changes in this bill are designed to affect those districts who have been unable to establish a transportation agreement with another district. Since these are very few in number, the fiscal impact is insignificant. The appropriation for foundation aid should provide adequate funding for these few instances. Therefore, the fiscal note is \$0.00.
