Narrative:

Portions of this bill resulting in increased workload for the Insurance Department include Section 1 - Health Care Commission, Section 3 - accreditation of "accredited capitated providers" and "health provider cooperatives", Section 15 - Medical Savings Accounts, and Sections 18-21 - health insurance reforms. It is estimated that one additional FTE analyst, 0.5 FTE attorney, and 0.5 FTE examiner positions would be required during the 1995-97
