Narrative: It would appear that the Appropriation included in Section 37 and 38 of House Bill 1050 would provide the necessary funds to the Health Department to carry-out the additional duties assigned to the Department under HB 1050.

It appears that there are many changes to title 26 and title 50 (NDCC) included in HB1050; therefore we would suggest that you request Fiscal notes from the Insurance Department and the Department of Human Services.

It may also help to obtain a revenue estimate from the Tax Department since Section 33 through 35 appear to change the tax code and the Income Tax rates.
