Narrative: The House removed two sections of HB1090, specifically pertaining to money orders and deposit accounts held by a bank. Our original fiscal note (January 3, 1995) estimated that if HB1090 were passed as introduced, the Division would receive \$575,000 during the 1995-97 biennium, and approximately \$300,000 would be remitted the following biennium. As a result of the amendments adopted by the House, these numbers have been reduced to \$385,000 and \$200,000 respectively.
