1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general and special fund, counties, and cities.

Narrative: After the November election, the secretary of state's office purchased 28 complete sets of the North Dakota Century Code. Those sets will be given to the new legislators according to section 54-03-23, NDCC. There is the possibility that some legislators will return their sets of the North Dakota Century Code which can be given to new legislators. There is also the possibility that new legislators will not want a set of the century code. We cannot make predictions on expenses based on possibilities. We prefer to leave the fiscal note statement as previously prepared on January 6, 1995 at the same level.
