- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

This bill removes the deducts that occur when a school district does not meet accreditation standards. The elimination of the accreditation deducts has no fiscal impact, since no school district has ever lost funds as a result of this language. This year, 3 elementary schools were deducted for non-accreditation, but we anticipate that these funds will be reinstated prior to the end of the year because the districts will meet accreditation standards.

Note: The weighting factor and per pupil components of this bills allow for a reduction in the foundation aid line item of \$2,831,026. This reduction is not related to the elimination of accreditation deducts.
