1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

The Department of Corrections does not have the information available to it to estimate a fiscal impact for this bill. However, the Burleigh County Correctional Center has estimated that the revenue generated from passage of this bill would offset costs of approximately \$16,000 per year for Burleigh County. There are 11 Class I jails in the State which would be those jails primarily involved in work release programs for inmates.
