Narrative:

The amendment to HB 1298, which would essentially make the court of appeals permanent, will have no effect upon fiscal estimates set out in the fiscal note prepared 01/13/95. Approximately \$700 was expended during the 1993/95 biennium to support the court of appeals. Minimal fiscal effect is expected for future bienniums. Funding for the court of appeals has not been requested in HB 1002, the judicial branch appropriation bill.
