1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general and special fund, counties, and cities.

Narrative: In reviewing this bill, the Secretary of State's office feels that there will be a minimal fiscal impact for the state. Basically, charitable organizations will continue to get solicitation licenses. The bill does increase the cost for charities to file their annual reports. By paying the annual report fee however, the charitable organization automatically renews their solicitation license. Those organizations currently licensed will not be required to file a new application for a new license.

The bill establishes September 1 as the date when all annual reports must be filed.


