Narrative:

If enacted, HB 1404 will delay the collection of mobile home taxes one year beginning with 1996. The fiscal effect to the counties and cities will be the loss of one year's mobile home taxes during the 1995-97 biennium.

The fiscal effect to the state is a one-year loss of approximately \$4,500 per year to the State Medical Center.
