1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

This bill is a result of the initiated measure filed with the Secretary of State on January 9, 1995, legalizing video gaming.

This bill provides \$50,000,000 in county property tax relief, while requiring counties to deduct these amounts in computing their property taxes.

The bill also provides \$1,500,000 for gaming enforcement, upon approval of the Emergency Commission, to the Office of Attorney General. The Article of the Constitution cited should be changed to XI (rather than IX, which does not exist).
