1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general and special fund, counties, and cities.

Narrative: It is estimated that a presidential primary election in 1996 will cost the counties of this state a combined total of \$400,000. The 1992 Presidential Primary Election held in South Dakota cost \$397,000.

Below please find the election expenses in North Dakota since 1984. Please keep in mind that our ballots contain more offices on the ballot and the number of measures varies from year to year. Those factors have a major impact on the cost of elections in North Dakota. In 1992, Primary Election expenses in North Dakota totaled \$717,090. In 1988, Primary Election expenses in North Dakota totaled \$645,948. In 1984, Primary Election expenses in North Dakota totaled \$612,419.
