1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general and special fund, counties, and cities.

Narrative: It is estimated that a presidential primary contest in 1996 will cost the state general fund a minimum of \$275,000.

Below please find primary or special election expenses in North Dakota since 1984 based on ordinary election procedures. Please keep in mind that our ballots contain several offices and the number of measures on individual ballots varies from year to year. Those factors have a major impact on the cost of elections in North Dakota.

In 1992, Primary Election expenses in N D totaled \$717,090.

In 1992, Special Election expenses in N D totaled \$393,988

In 1988, Primary Election expenses in N D totaled \$645,948.

In 1987, Special Election expenses in N D totaled \$359,159

In 1984, Primary Election expenses in N D totaled \$612,419.

NOTE: The 1992 South Dakota Presidential Primary Election cost \$398,000.
