Each arrest for minors having a BAC in excess of .01 would result in a \$50 reinstatement fee prior to the drivers license reinstatement. It is estimated that approximately 600 arrests will be made by officers during the biennium. Any costs involved in administrating the changes in the law should be off-set by the reinstatement fees.
