1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general and special fund, counties, and cities.
Narrative: According to the Governor's office, there are close to 140 commissions and boards that the Governor must make appointments. That number is in transition now because of elimination and consolidation. Many other boards and commissions are found in the century code also. Our office does not anticipate the need for an additional person to handle the duties required of this bill as we have a staff person handling those types of duties now. We do have a storage problem however. We do not know how many documents (individual pages) would be transferred to us. Each agency and commission could have several boxes of records to transfer. We would ask all agencies to microfilm the documents before transferring the minutes and financial records to us. Microfilming records is expensive and each board or commission would have to provide their own fiscal analysis of the impact on them. In time, all records and minutes transferred to us would be transferred to the State Archives.


