- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

A school receives one-half foundation aid payment for each student being monitored by a certified teacher employed by the school. More parents are taking the National Teachers Exam and are qualifying for supervising home-based instruction and therefore, it is anticipated that the cost for monitoring will decrease. The proposed legislation would drop the requirement to provide monitoring for parents after two years of home-based instruction involvement. This would also reduce the amount of foundation aid payments required for the school districts providing monitoring.
