**FISCAL NOTE NARRATIVE
HB1493**

The North Dakota University System has 966 licensed motor vehicles which would be affected by this bill. This vehicle count is based on the number of vehicle credit cards State Fleet Services has issued to the University System.

An additional five FTE's would be required to perform the additional workload. Total cost for FTE's operating expenses and purchase of motor vehicles would be \$13,346,800.

In addition, \$3,750,000 (\$250,000 shop overhead and \$3,500,000 inventory) needs to be added to the Highways Program in the NDDOT budget. This is so the NDDOT can provide the Fleet with inventory and shop services. These items are budgeted and paid for by the NDDOT and subsequently reimbursed by State Fleet based on actual usage.
