Narrative:

As amended, SB 2040 provides that judges can impose an additional period of probation for sex offenders "if the additional period of probation is in conjunction with a commitment to a sexual offender treatment or aftercare program." The Department of Corrections does not believe this amendment will affect the fiscal note. Generally, the Department anticipated that it would be in cases where extended treatment was necessary that judges would impose the additional period of probation.
