1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

This bill eliminates the distinctions between in-city and rural transportation. The payment for pupil days is increased to \$.40, and all students who are transported on vehicles with capacities of 10 or more are eligible for this payment. The miles driven by "in-city" vehicles would also be funded under this proposal. These changes require \$400,798 over the 1993-95 appropriation for transportation in the foundation aid line item. This amount is contained in the Governor's Budget Recommendation contained in SB 2013.
