Requested by Legislative Council Date of Request: 03-22-95

1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

This bill does not have an appropriation clause, since transportation aid is contained in SB 2013. However, to fund every school district at a level equivalent to the amount received for transportation during the 1994-95 school year would require approximately \$35,200,000. The portion of the foundation aid line item that has been set aside for transportation is slightly over \$36,000,000. The \$800,000 difference would be used to fund appeals from school districts who experienced a 5% increase in the number of miles driven or students transported.
