1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

If Senate Bill 2122 passes and unlimited discovery is permitted, the Department of Transportation could require the services of an attorney on approximately 2000 hearings per biennium. If we were to use attorneys from the Attorney General's Office, the cost per biennium would be approximately \$84,800 (2000 hearings x \$42.44 hourly attorney fee x 1 hour per hearing). If the Attorney General's staff is not available, we would use private attorneys at a substantially higher cost.
