Narrative: The purpose of this bill is to allow the secretary of states office, at some time in the future, to allow private vendors like banks, other lending agencies, attorney's and other parties to access data about corporations and uniform commercial code filings from our office directly from their office. Those businesses would not have to place phone calls to get general information about documents on file in the secretary of state's office. The figures below reflect the estimated revenue and expenditures should the secretary of state's office decide to implement the program before the next biennium.
