- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

An estimated \$700,000 annually would be lost to the rural fire districts due to the federal court decision disallowing the collection of insurance premium tax on federally subsidized multi-peril crop insurance. This bill provides for a consistent funding level for the rural fire districts by reverting to a set \$5.2 million appropriation rather than 84 percent of premium tax collected on the specified lines of insurance.
