Narrative:

The Division of Parole and Probation has developed and piloted a number of the intermediate measures outlined in the bill with the cooperation of the Cass County District Court over the last two years. It has learned that giving the Parole Officer the discretion to impose agreed upon constraints with an offender has increased the chance of a successful completion of supervision and reduced the number committed to the State Penitentiary. The Division does not project any fiscal impact from this bill as any funding that may be required is in the Governor's Executive Budget for the Division.
