Requested by Legislative Council Date of Request: 1-17-95

- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: SB 2195 amends the checkoff collected by the Milk Stabilization Board of not more than eight cents per hundredweight to not more than fourteen cents. This fund like the other Agricultural Commodity promotion groups is appropriated on a continuing basis. The dairy processors voted to approve this checkoff amendment, since they pay this checkoff. This checkoff has not been amended since 1975. (This amendment reduces the checkoff from not more than fourteen cents to not more than eleven cents.)
