Narrative: The bill will have a negligible impact. It will increase special funds revenues by \$7,500 per biennium. It will possibly increase general funds expenditures by \$4,900 per biennium. These funds would be from other agency budgets as a result of contractors' fees being passed on, but it is impossible to predict. It could increase special funds expenditures by \$7,500 per biennium, an amount equal to the increase in income. These funds are in a continuing appropriation authorized under 55-03-04 NDCC.
