Narrative:

The amendment does not change the original fiscal note. Temporary exhibits range in cost from \$1,000 to \$15,000, and vary in duration. Admission charges will be set to recover costs, so while special funds will show both positive and negative effects, the end result will be budget neutral. This is enabling legislation only; no specific exhibits have been targeted, so specific projections are not possible at this time.
