Narrative:.. This amendment allows a unit of government to apply to the abandoned motor vehicle disposal fund for reimbursement of towing or storage expenses. It is estimated that this could impact the fund by \$182,500. This estimate was based on the city of Bismarck which represents 8% of the population & had 73 abandoned vehicles which could be reimbursed from the fund (73 div.by 8% x \$100 x2)
