Requested by Legislative Council Date of Request 2-8-95

- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: This bill, as amended, allows a unit of government to apply to the abandoned motor vehicle disposal fund for reimbursement of towing or storage expenses, not to exceed \$50 per vehicle. It is estimated that this could impact the fund by \$91,250. This estimate was based on the city of Bismarck which represents 8% of the population & had 73 abandoned vehicles which could be reimbursed from the fund (73 div.by 8% x \$50 x2)
