This bill puts into statute the current practice in regard to assets of reorganized districts particularly as they relate to transportation payments. When two districts go through the reorganization process and become one the assets and liabilities of both separate districts become the assets and liabilities of the newly formed district. Transportation payments would be included. Therefore there would be no fiscal impact from previous reorganizations. The impact for future reorganizations is difficult to estimate but is included in or covered by foundation aid and transportation appropriations.
