1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Senate Bill 2248 as amended provides that transportation payments due districts that cease to exist between the close of the 93-94 school year and the beginning of the 94-95 school year will be distributed to the districts who received the students from the districts that went out of business in proportion to the total number of students in the former district. There are 13 districts in this category. The money to pay for these transportation costs is in the current biennium's foundation line and will not result in an additional expenditure from state sources. Paying this transportation money out in the fashion described in the bill will result in a very slight
