Requested by Legislative Council Date of Request: 1-17-95

1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general and special fund, counties, and cities.

Narrative: The secretary of state's office estimates that the \$2.50 surcharge on UCC documents established with a new section of law by the 1993 Legislative assembly will generate \$250,000. The income from the surcharge was to replace an estimated \$400,000 income short fall in UCC/CNS income during the 1993-1995 biennium.

If the surcharge were to remain in effect, this office would estimate that income from the surcharge would be about the same for future bienniums. Thus \$250,000 would come into the Secretary of State's office which would go to a special fund for county use.

Expenditures to implement the accounting and programming responsibilities of this bill would be less than \$5,000 a biennium.
