Narrative: Senate Bill 2391 allows a state entity to charge a reasonable fee to access electronically stored information. Presumably the collected fee will be deposited in the state entity's fund. ISD will assist the entity in making the electronic information available to a customer. ISD will also assure that the integrity of the data base is not compromised by individuals accessing it.
