HOUSE BILL NO. 1032 (Legislative Council) (Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 48-01.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the multiple prime bid requirement for public improvement contracts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 48-01.1-06 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

48-01.1-06. Bid requirements for public buildings. Multiple prime bids for the general, electrical, and mechanical portions of a project are required when any individual general, electrical, or mechanical contract is in excess of <u>fifty one hundred</u> thousand dollars. The governing body may also allow submission of single prime bids or bids for other portions of the project at its discretion. The governing body may not accept the single prime bid unless that bid is lower than the combined total of the lowest and best multiple bids for the project.
