- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 50-06-14.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to projects involving services for the alzheimer's and related dementia population; to
- 3 amend and reenact the new section to chapter 23-09.3 and the new section to chapter 23-16 of
- 4 the North Dakota Century Code as created by sections 2 and 3 of chapter 254 of the 1995
- 5 Session Laws, relating to a moratorium on basic care and long-term care bed capacity; and to
- 6 declare an emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** The new section to chapter 23-09.3 of the North Dakota
- 9 Century Code as created by section 2 of chapter 254 of the 1995 Session Laws is amended
- 10 and reenacted as follows:
- 11 Moratorium on expansion of basic care bed capacity. During the period after
- 12 July 31, 1995, and before August 1, 1997, Except when existing beds are converted for use by
- 13 the alzheimer's and related dementia population under the projects provided for in section
- 14 50-06-14.4, the state department of health and consolidated laboratories may not issue a
- 15 license under this chapter for any additional bed capacity unless the expanded bed capacity
- 16 was approved by the health council under chapter 23-17.2 before August 1, 1995 above the
- 17 <u>state's gross capacity of one thousand four hundred seventy-one beds during the period</u>
- 18 <u>between August 1, 1997, and July 31, 1999</u>.
- 19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** The new section to chapter 23-16 of the North Dakota
- 20 Century Code as created by section 3 of chapter 254 of the 1995 Session Laws is amended
- 21 and reenacted as follows:
- 22 Moratorium on expansion of long-term care bed capacity. Notwithstanding sections
- 23 23-16-06 and 23-16-10, during the period after July 31, 1995, and before August 1, 1997
- 24 except when existing beds are converted for use by the alzheimer's and related dementia

- 1 population under the projects provided for in section 50-06-14.4, the state department of health
- 2 and consolidated laboratories may not issue a license for any additional bed capacity unless
- 3 the expanded bed capacity was approved by the health council under chapter 23-17.2 before
- 4 August 1, 1995 above the state's gross capacity of seven thousand one hundred twenty-four
- 5 beds during the period between August 1, 1997, and July 31, 1999.
- SECTION 3. Section 50-06-14.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 **50-06-14.4. Alzheimer's and related dementia projects.** The department of human
- 9 services shall establish projects designed to meet the service needs of the alzheimer's and
- 10 related dementia population. The projects established under this section must explore the
- 11 <u>financial and service viability of converting existing nursing facility or basic care capacity to a</u>
- 12 <u>specific service environment that targets the alzheimer's and related dementia population. The</u>
- 13 state department of health shall cooperate with the department to ensure the success of the
- 14 projects. The projects may be established notwithstanding subsections 2, 5, 10, and 11 and
- 15 <u>subdivision c of subsection 9 of section 50-24.5-01, relating to definitions for aid to aged, blind,</u>
- and disabled persons, and subsection 1 of section 23-09.3-01, relating to the definition of a
- 17 basic care facility.
- **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
