- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 27-20 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to school personnel notification of juvenile offenses; and to amend and
- 3 reenact subsection 4 of section 27-20-51 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to school
- 4 personnel receipt of juvenile orders of disposition or adjudications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 27-20-51 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 4. Following an adjudication of delinquency for an offense that would be a felony if committed by an adult, The juvenile's supervisor shall:
 - a. Forward the order of disposition or other adjudication to the juvenile's school principal, or chief administrative officer, or designated school guidance counselor, if requested, must be allowed access to the disposition order if:
 - (1) The offense would constitute a felony were it committed by an adult;
 - (2) The offense was committed on school property;
 - (3) The offense involved a crime against a person;
 - (4) The offense was related to the use, possession, purchase, or trafficking of marijuana, narcotic drugs, or other controlled substances; or
 - (5) The offense involved the use or possession of a dangerous weapon;
 - <u>b.</u> Notify the juvenile's parents or guardian, in writing, when an order has been forwarded as required by this subsection;
 - c. Notify the juvenile's school principal or chief administrative officer that, notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the principal or officer may obtain additional information about the proceeding from the supervisor after informing the juvenile's parent or guardian; and
