ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1052

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for the reimbursement of school districts
2 expending funds for technology.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in
5 the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,800,000, or so
6 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the superintendent of public instruction for the
7 purpose of reimbursing school districts for technology expenditures, for the biennium beginning
8 July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999. The superintendent shall determine the maximum
9 amount to which each school district is entitled by dividing the number of elementary and
10 secondary students in average daily membership in this state into the funds appropriated by
11 this section and then multiplying the result by the number of students in average daily
12 membership in the district. Upon receiving substantiating documentation from a school district
13 indicating the expenditure of funds on or after July 1, 1997, has been used for the acquisition of
14 computer technology for student uses or instructional purposes, interactive television, or
15 teacher inservice programs related to the use of computer technology in classroom instruction,
16 the superintendent shall provide reimbursement to the school district in an amount equal to that
17 expended but not exceeding that to which the school district is entitled.
