- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 and a new
- 2 subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of
- 3 upland game and nonresident upland game license fees; to amend and reenact section
- 4 20.1-03-07.1 and subsection 37 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 5 relating to nonresident upland game licenses and nonresident waterfowl hunting license fees;
- 6 and to repeal section 20.1-03-07.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to nonresident
- 7 youth hunting licenses.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 9 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 of the 1995 Supplement to the
- 10 North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 11 <u>"Upland game" includes all varieties of grouse, partridge, pheasants, and tree</u>
- 12 squirrels.
- 13 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the
- 14 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl and upland game hunting licenses**
- 16 **required.** Except as provided in section 20.1-03-07.2, a A nonresident may not hunt waterfowl
- 17 <u>or upland game</u> unless that person first obtains a nonresident waterfowl <u>or upland game</u>
- 18 hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license. The nonresident
- 19 waterfowl hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any period of fourteen
- 20 consecutive days or any two periods of seven consecutive days each and in specified waterfowl
- 21 hunting zones. The nonresident upland game hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt
- 22 upland game for any two periods of seven consecutive days each during the first forty-five days
- 23 of the upland game hunting season. A nonresident waterfowl hunting license authorizing two
- 24 7-day hunting periods may allow hunting in a different waterfowl hunting zone during each

- 1 period. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall specify various waterfowl hunting
- 2 zones for which nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses will be available, and may shall specify
- 3 the number of licenses which may to be issued in each zone and the manner in which they are
- 4 to be issued. A nonresident is entitled to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting
- 5 license <u>and one nonresident upland game hunting license</u> per year. <u>The department may</u>
- 6 adopt rules to implement this section.
- 7 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 37 of section 20.1-03-12 of the 1995
- 8 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 37. For a nonresident waterfowl hunting license, ten ninety dollars.
- **SECTION 4.** A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the 1995 Supplement to the
- 11 North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 12 <u>For a nonresident upland game hunting license, ninety dollars.</u>
- 13 **SECTION 5. REPEAL.** Section 20.1-03-07.2 of the 1995 Supplement to the North
- 14 Dakota Century Code is repealed.
