- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 50-06.2-02 and a new
- 2 section to chapter 50-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to projects involving
- 3 expanded case management for long-term care.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 50-06.2-02 of the 1995 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- "Case management" means a process in which a professional case manager
   assesses the needs of the client; arranges, coordinates, monitors, and evaluates
   services; and advocates to meet the client's specific needs in the least restrictive
   environment.
  - **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 50-06.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Expanded case management system project. The department of human services
  shall establish a project designed to provide an expanded case management system for
- 15 individuals in need of long-term care services. The expanded case management system
- 16 established under this section must provide accessibility to all necessary services for the
- 17 individual and the individual's family through the individual's case manager. The project must
- 18 provide for the completion by the case management agency of a uniform, computerized,
- 19 comprehensive assessment for each applicant in need of long-term care services. The state
- 20 department of health shall cooperate with the department to ensure the success of the project.
