- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-19.1-18 and 43-19.1-22 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the registration of professional engineers and land surveyors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-19.1-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **43-19.1-18. Registration fees.** The board shall establish registration fees for professional engineers, engineers-in-training, land surveyors, and land surveyors-in-training in the amount the board determines necessary to accomplish the purposes of the board as provided in this chapter, but. The registration fees may not to exceed the amount of fifty dollars for a one-year period or one hundred dollars for a two-year period. If the board denies the issuance of a certificate to an applicant, the fee paid may be retained as an application fee.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-19.1-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 **43-19.1-22.** Expirations and renewals. Certificates of registration expire on the last 15 day of the month of December following thirty-first of the year of their issuance if registration is 16 on an annual basis and of the year after their issuance if issued on a biennial basis, and 17 become invalid after that date unless renewed. It is the duty of the The secretary of the board 18 to shall notify every person registered under this chapter of the date of the expiration of said 19 that person's certificate of registration and the amount of fee required for its renewal. Such The 20 notice must be mailed to the registrant at his the registrant's last known address at least one 21 month in advance of the expiration of said the registrant's certificate. Renewal may be effected 22 at any time prior to before or during the month of December by the payment of a fee as 23 established by the board, not to exceed the fees established in section 43-19.1-18.
