1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-12-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to weight-restricted roads.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-12-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-12-03. Commissioner or local authorities may limit use of vehicles on**
7 **highways.** ~~Whenever any~~ If a highway will be seriously damaged or destroyed by reason of
8 deterioration, rain, snow, or other climatic conditions unless the use of vehicles is prohibited or
9 the weight of the vehicle thereon vehicles is limited, the commissioner director or employees
10 authorized by him the director by an order, and local authorities by ordinance or resolution, may
11 prohibit the operation of vehicles upon such the highway or may impose restrictions as to the
12 weight of vehicles. The commissioner director or employees making such the order and local
13 authorities enacting any such the ordinance or resolution shall erect or cause to be have
14 erected and maintained signs designating the provisions of the order, ordinance, or resolution.
15 ~~Such~~ The signs must be erected and maintained at each end of that the portion of any highway
16 affected thereby by the order, ordinance, or resolution, and such the order, ordinance, or
17 resolution is not effective until such the signs are erected and maintained. The operation of
18 trucks or other commercial vehicles or weight limitations as to the weight thereof on trucks or
19 other commercial vehicles on designated highways may be prohibited or limited in the same
20 manner. On highways as they enter this state, the director shall place an additional sign above
21 any sign designating weight limitations on trucks and other commercial vehicles. This
22 additional sign must list the maximum axle weight in two hundred point type in black letters on
23 an orange background.
