1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-07.1 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to waterfowl hunting by nonresidents born in North Dakota.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1995 Supplement to the
5 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required.** Except as provided
7 in section 20.1-03-07.2, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that person first obtains a
8 nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license.
9 The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles ~~the~~ a nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any
10 period of fourteen consecutive days ~~or~~, any two periods of seven consecutive days each ~~and~~,
11 or if the nonresident was born in this state, any four 4-day periods in specified waterfowl
12 hunting zones. A license authorizing two 7-day hunting periods or any four 4-day periods may
13 allow hunting in a different zone during each period. A nonresident may prove birth in this state
14 by providing at the time the license is purchased a valid birth certificate showing that that
15 person was born in this state or by providing other evidence determined satisfactory by the
16 director. The governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall specify various waterfowl hunting
17 zones for which nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses will be available, and may specify the
18 number of licenses which may be issued in each zone and the manner in which they are to be
19 issued. A nonresident is entitled to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license
20 per year and must purchase the license from the Bismarck office of the department.
