- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to continuing education of barbers; and to amend and reenact sections
- 3 43-04-07 and 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the state board of barber
- 4 examiners and fees.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 43-04-07. Compensation Expenses How paid. Each member of the board shall is
- 9 entitled to receive thirty dollars per day daily compensation for actual services in an amount not
- 10 to exceed the amount provided for in section 54-03-19.2 for members of the legislative
- 11 <u>compensation commission</u> for actual services, and must also be paid his for actual expenses,
- 12 as provided by law, incurred in attending meetings of the board and in the performance of his
- 13 performing official duties. All funds collected or received by the board must be deposited and
- 14 disbursed in accordance with section 54-44-12.
- 15 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 16 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 17 **43-04-42. Fees.** The fees to be paid by an applicant are as follows
- 18 <u>1. The board may charge applicants the following types of fees in an amount</u> 19 determined by the board by rule:
- 4. <u>a.</u> For examination for <u>and issuance of</u> a certificate to practice master barbering,
   twenty dollars.

For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one g. 9 hundred twenty-five dollars. 10 <del>10.</del> For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifteen dollars, to be paid by h. 11 each shopowner in advance. For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section 12 <del>11.</del> į. 13 43-04-38.1, one hundred twenty-five dollars. 14 For A penalty fee for restoration of an expired barbershop license, a ten dollar <del>12.</del> į. 15 penalty fee in addition to the annual license fee. 16 2. Each application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be 17 accompanied by a the fee of fifty dollars determined by the board to cover 18 expenses of inspection, which must be retained by the board and deposited as 19 other fees. 20 A duplicate license, certificate, or permit will must be issued upon the filing of: 3. 21 Filing a statement <del>covering</del> verified by the oath of the applicant which 22 explains the loss of the same, verified by the oath of the applicant, and 23 submitting; 24 Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and the payment of b. 25 Paying a fee of fifty cents determined by the board for the issuance of the C. 26 duplicate. The board has the power to reduce renewal fees below the 27 amounts heretofore set out in this section whenever the board determines that 28 the full amount is not necessary to finance the necessary and regular 29 operations of the board. Such reduction must be made by the board only by 30 applying an equal percentage of reduction to all renewal fees provided for in

1		this chapter, and such reduction must be made when commencing the
2		licensing year and is in effect for the whole of such year.
3	<u>4.</u>	Anyone becoming who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United
4		States in time of war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while
5		in good standing as to payment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration of his
