- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-40.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to tuition payments for noneducational placements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-40.2-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15-40.2-03. Tuition payments. Except as provided in section 15-40.2-04, <u>a</u> school districts district educating <u>pupils</u> <u>a student</u> in <u>other another</u> school <u>districts</u> district shall pay the full cost of education incurred by the receiving district <u>if the placement is for educational</u>

9 purposes. The placing agency shall pay the full cost of education incurred by the receiving

district if the placement is for noneducational purposes. The costs full cost of education must

11 be determined on the basis of the receiving district's full-time equivalent average daily

12 membership and must include annual expenditures from the general fund and annual

13 educational expenditures from all special funds; provided, that only those expenditures

14 permitted in determining the educational cost per pupil student in section 15-40.1-06 may be

included in determining the receiving district's current operating expenses. To the district's

16 current operating expense for kindergarten, elementary, or high school students, as the case

may be, except special education students where a fair rental charge for each student for

18 capital outlay must be determined by the department superintendent of public instruction, must

19 be added the statewide total of all school districts' annual expenditures from sinking and

20 interest funds, plus the statewide total of all school districts' annual tax receipts to the building

21 funds, including any amounts expended from school districts' general funds for capital outlay,

22 divided by the average daily membership of the state. From this amount, the following must be

23 deducted for each individual pupil student:

- Such State payments as are received by the admitting district for that pupil from state payments received by the admitting district student, less the average amount per North Dakota resident pupil student enrolled in the school district realized from the amounts provided for in subsection 3 of section 15-40.1-06; and
 - A credit applied for any school taxes paid to the admitting district by the parent or guardian of the admitted pupil student.

The amount remaining is the tuition charge for the individual pupil <u>student</u>, and must be paid under this chapter.

If the district of residence and the parent or guardian are both paying tuition, the credit allowed under this section for taxes paid to the admitting district by the parent or guardian must be credited to the district of residence and the parent or guardian in proportion to the amount of tuition paid by each.

Nothing contained in this chapter affects the right of a school district to charge and collect such tuition as may be fixed by agreement from pupils students who are not residents of this state, in accordance with section 15-40.2-10.
