- 1 A BILL for an Act relating to the provision of guidance and counseling services at the
- 2 elementary and secondary school level.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. School guidance and counseling services Providers.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other law, guidance and counseling services at the elementary and
- 6 secondary school level may be provided by a person holding a graduate degree from a
- 7 regionally or nationally accredited institution of higher education in school counseling. A person
- 8 without a school counseling degree may be certified by the superintendent of public instruction
- 9 through an alternate procedure if the person meets specific academic and training standards
- 10 adopted by the superintendent of public instruction. The determination of the specific
- 11 standards must be made by the superintendent of public instruction in consultation with the
- 12 academic departments offering school counseling graduate programs in this state. The
- 13 absence of a teaching certificate or teaching experience may not be used as cause for denial of
- 14 an applicant's certificate. Hiring a counselor under this section may not be cause for loss of a
- 15 school's accreditation.
