- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the provision of nursing services in the public schools.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

School health services. The state department of health shall establish two pilot programs, one in a rural school district and one in an urban school district, to provide for the services of registered nurses in the public schools of this state. A local school board or consortium may contract directly for the provision of these services with a registered nurse who meets the licensing requirements of the state board of nursing and who is a registered nurse employed by an entity that provides nursing services. The registered nurse's duties may include, subject to parental consent, providing health readiness examinations for students beginning school, providing health screenings, being a resource for disease prevention, providing services for students with special needs, and providing referrals for diagnostic tests. The registered nurse's duties may also include the review of immunization records, the provision of first aid, the provision of teacher inservice training programs and staff wellness activities, the development of school district health policies, and participation in health and safety programs. A registered nurse providing services under this section shall abide by the provisions of sections 15-47-49 and 15-47-50, as stated in the nurse's contract. Each local school district or consortium participating in the program is responsible for providing office supplies, restocking medical supplies, and for the monthly cost of a cellular telephone. Each participating school district or consortium shall establish a school health services committee to determine which duties should be provided by the nurse.
