1 A BILL for an Act relating to dogs running at large; and to declare an emergency.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 3 **SECTION 1. Dogs running at large Liability for damage or injury.** The owner of a
- 4 dog may not permit the dog to run at large and cause damage. The owner of a dog is liable for
- 5 any damage to the property of another person and for any injury to any individual caused by the
- 6 dog running at large, as well as for any costs incurred by a political subdivision or law
- 7 enforcement agency in capturing and impounding the dog. If the owner of a dog is a minor, the
- 8 duties and responsibilities created by this section are imputed to the parent or legal guardian of
- 9 the minor.
- 10 **SECTION 2. Dogs running at large Capture.** Unless a board of county
- 11 commissioners by resolution identifies another person or entity responsible for the capture and
- 12 impoundment of dogs running at large, as authorized by section 11-11-14, the county sheriff
- 13 shall capture any dog running at large which the sheriff believes to be dangerous and impound
- 14 the dog at an animal shelter or facility designated by the board of county commissioners. If
- 15 seventy-two hours after impoundment the dog remains unclaimed, the animal shelter or facility
- 16 having control of the dog shall perform euthanasia or cause euthanasia to be performed on the
- 17 dog.
- **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
